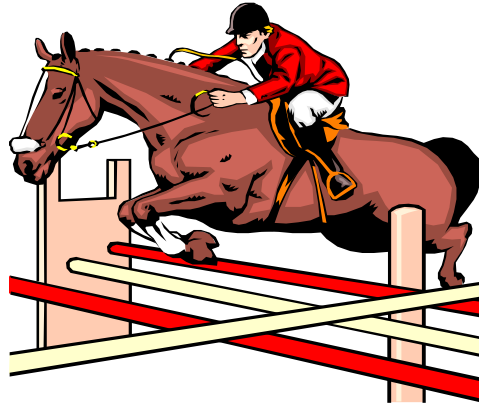

SHOWJUMPING

RING 1 HORSES and PONIES 9.30am START

HORSES AND PONIES WILL BE JUDGED SEPARATELY
Classes 1-6 POINTS SYSTEM FOR CLUB MEMBERS

- Class 1 Nursery Stakes – 0.61m (2'0")**
(Not to have won first more than **3** times in this class)
Cannot enter Classes 3 - 6 competitively.
- Class 2 GIVE IT A GO – 0.69m (2'3")**
Cannot enter classes 5 & 6 competitively.
- Class 3 SMALL NOVICE - 0.76m (2'6")**
Cannot enter class 6 competitively.
- Class 4 NOVICE - 0.84m (2'9")**
- Class 5 INTERMEDIATE - 0.92m (3'0")**
- Class 6 OPEN - 0.99m (3'3")**

Entry fees: Classes 1 – 6: Members **£5.00** Non-Members **£8.00**

Prizes: Class 1- Keep trophy to class winner and rosettes to 6th place.

Classes 2-6 – prize money to class winner and rosettes to 6th

(Separate prizes for horses and ponies **unless insufficient entries**)

(Two Phase Jumping in operation in classes 2-6 unless otherwise advised)

RING 2 CLEAR ROUND MINIMUS 9.30am START

(not running during classes 7-9)

Entry at Gate: **£2.00** Rosettes for all clear rounds

A full showjumping course. Competitors can alter height as required.

BEGINNERS JUMPING

11.00am START

(ENTRIES IN THESE CLASSES CANNOT ENTER ANY CLASSES IN RING 1)

POINTS SYSTEM FOR CLUB MEMBERS

- Class 7 LEAD REIN – 0.38m (1'3")**
Cannot enter classes 8 & 9 competitively.
- Class 8 STARTER STAKES – 0.45m (1'6")**
(competitors may be accompanied but not lead)
- Class 9 MINI NOVICE – 0.53m (1'9")**
(competitors may not be accompanied)

Entry fees: Classes 7-9: Members **£3.00** Non-Members **£4.00 (enter at tent)**

Rosettes to 6th place and keep trophy to class winner.

SHOWING

POINTS SYSTEM FOR CLUB MEMBERS (Ridden and Non Ridden)

RING 3

9.30AM START

- Class 1. BEST TURNED OUT HORSE/PONY AND RIDER**
Judged on turn-out, suitability and manners. **In hand or ridden.**
Lead rein entries acceptable. No show required.
- Class 2. BEST RIDER ON LEAD REIN/ FIRST RIDDEN**
Riders on lead rein may not enter other classes off the lead rein.
No age limit. Judged on performance and manners. No cantering or jumping.
Non lead competitors may be accompanied.
- Class 3. BEST RIDER ANY AGE**
Judged on performance and manners. (Lead rein entries **not** accepted)
- Class 4. JUDGES FAVORITE HORSE/PONY IN HAND OR RIDDEN**
- Class 5. BEST HANDLER AND HORSE/PONY (IN HAND)**
Judged on performance, manners and handlers ability.
- Class 6. MOUNTAIN AND MOORLAND (IN HAND)**
- Class 7. BEST ALL ROUND HORSE/PONY AND RIDER**
Judged on suitability of rider and mount, performance and manners. A short show will be required and may include a small jump. Lead rein entries not acceptable. (Class may be split into age groups if sufficient entries)
- Class 8. COLOURED HORSE/PONY IN HAND OR RIDDEN**
- Class 9. VETERAN HORSE/PONY**
18 years and over. **In hand or ridden.**
Judged on performance, manners and condition.

Riding hats must be worn by junior handlers (17 years and under)

Entry Fees: Classes 1 – 9 Members **£4.00** Non-members **£6.00**

Rosettes to 6th Place and keep trophy to class winner.

Classes may be split if sufficient entries

Entries at the ringside taken after 12 noon

5 GAMES TO BE ANNOUNCED ON THE DAY
CONSOLATION RACE for all non rosette winners

Group A: **LEADING REIN – 5 YEARS AND UNDER**

Group B: **LEADING REIN – 6 YEARS AND OVER**

Riders in groups A & B may not enter other classes off the lead rein

Group C: **10 YEARS AND UNDER**

Group D: **11 – 14 YEARS**

Group E: **OPEN**

1. All faults must be corrected at the time they occur.
2. All ages are as on 1st January 2010.
3. Points system applies to each age group for Club members

Entry Fees:Members **£1.50** Non-members **£2.00**

£1.00 Charge per competitor towards First Aid cover

Rosettes to 4th place (and to all entrants in groups A & B) and keep trophy to each age group winner. (Trophies only awarded if more than 3 entries per class)

RULES

1. It is a condition of entry that each entrant shall agree to indemnify the organisers against any legal action arising from any accident, damage, loss, injury or illness to horses, owners, riders, spectators or any person or property whatsoever.
2. The schedule will run as printed unless exceptional circumstances prevail when any alteration will be at the sole discretion of the organisers. No entry fee will be refunded unless the class is cancelled.
3. The organisers reserve the right to amend or alter any classes with insufficient entries.
4. Correct dress & footwear to be worn when competing. All riders must wear headgear to **current safety standards** at all times when mounted. Riding hats must be worn by all junior handlers (17 years and under). It is strongly recommended that body protectors are worn over or under riding jackets.
5. Riders competing on the lead rein may not competitively enter any other classes off the lead rein.
6. Whips and spurs are not permitted in gymkhana games.
7. Excessive use of whip or spurs will not be permitted and may result in expulsion from the showground.
8. The practise jump is to be jumped from one direction only and is only for the use of riders entering the jumping classes. It is not to exceed the height of jumps in the class in progress.
9. Any horse or pony considered unfit by the organisers may be asked to leave the showground.
10. Any objection must be made to the secretary within 15 minutes of the incident occurring. A deposit of £20.00 must be submitted which will be returned if the objection is sustained.
11. All vehicles parked at owner's risk.
12. Dogs must be kept on leads at all times.
13. Height restrictions will be enforced and passport verification will be requested.
