

**For Sale – Great Lead Rein Pony
11.2 hh Welsh Sec A, Grey Gelding**



Gadlys Trapeze is registered Welsh Section A, a sprightly 17 years old and is known as Kylie. We've had him for 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ years, during which he has taught my daughters to ride and given many of their friends the opportunity to ride too. In 2009, he has done rallies and Mini Camp with the Belvoir Pony Club, giving his rider the confidence to go off the lead rein. At The Spalding & District show last month he brought home rosettes in showing and gymkhana games.

Kylie is snaffle mouthed, has good feet & is unshod. He lives off very little, living out most of the year, although comes in during the worst of the winter weather. To our knowledge (and speaking to 2 previous owners), he's not had laminitis, although he can get quite a tummy so I do watch his grazing.

With his previous owners, he was successfully shown at Ponies UK level. We have shown him locally and have always brought home rosettes. He has done very well in lead rein showing classes. We have also done every gymkhana game with him – he is not the fastest but is totally unflappable. He will canter when really kicked on, but will happily trot and is unphased by flags, hoops, letters etc. He enjoys jumping - either from a trot or again, if kicked on, a steady canter.

He is 100% bombproof in traffic – from a vintage tractor rally, to dustbin lorry, he is absolutely reliable. No problems travelling – box / trailer, blacksmith, dentist, worming & vaccinations up to date.

Kylie is a true lead rein pony and performs best with someone at his shoulder. He can go off the lead rein but he takes a lot of kicking on and sometimes won't go forward. My daughter has hacked and jumped off the lead rein, with another pony in the lead.

Kylie is for sale as my eldest daughter has had a massive growth spurt and to buy a new pony, my husband has said "1 out before 1 in!" Also, Kylie has a lot to give and it would be a shame for him not to be fussed over and kept busy by another family. He's been brilliant with my 3 year old on the lead – she sits on him like he's a sofa! However, he would also be ideal for an 8+ year old child who is on the lead rein as he is stocky enough to take a longer leg.
